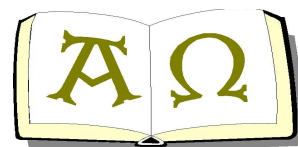

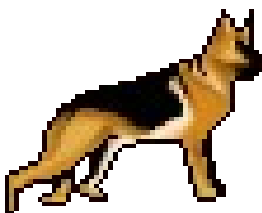
Q.. What kind of man was Boaz before he married Ruth?
